‘Techno Innovators’ Binary Club Activity for MBA (2015-17) Batch Students

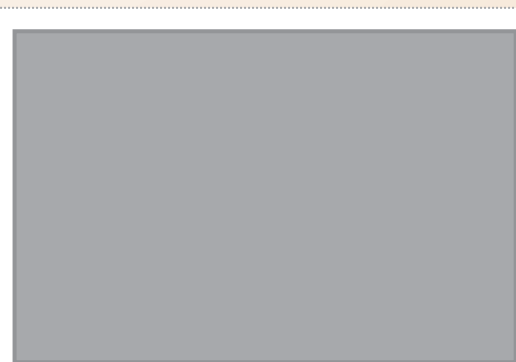
November 19, 2015

October 15-16, 2015

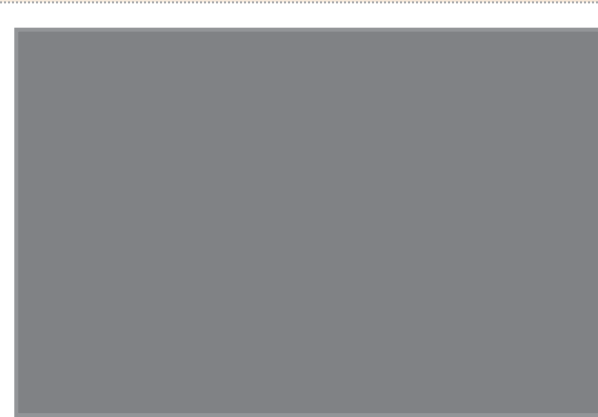
