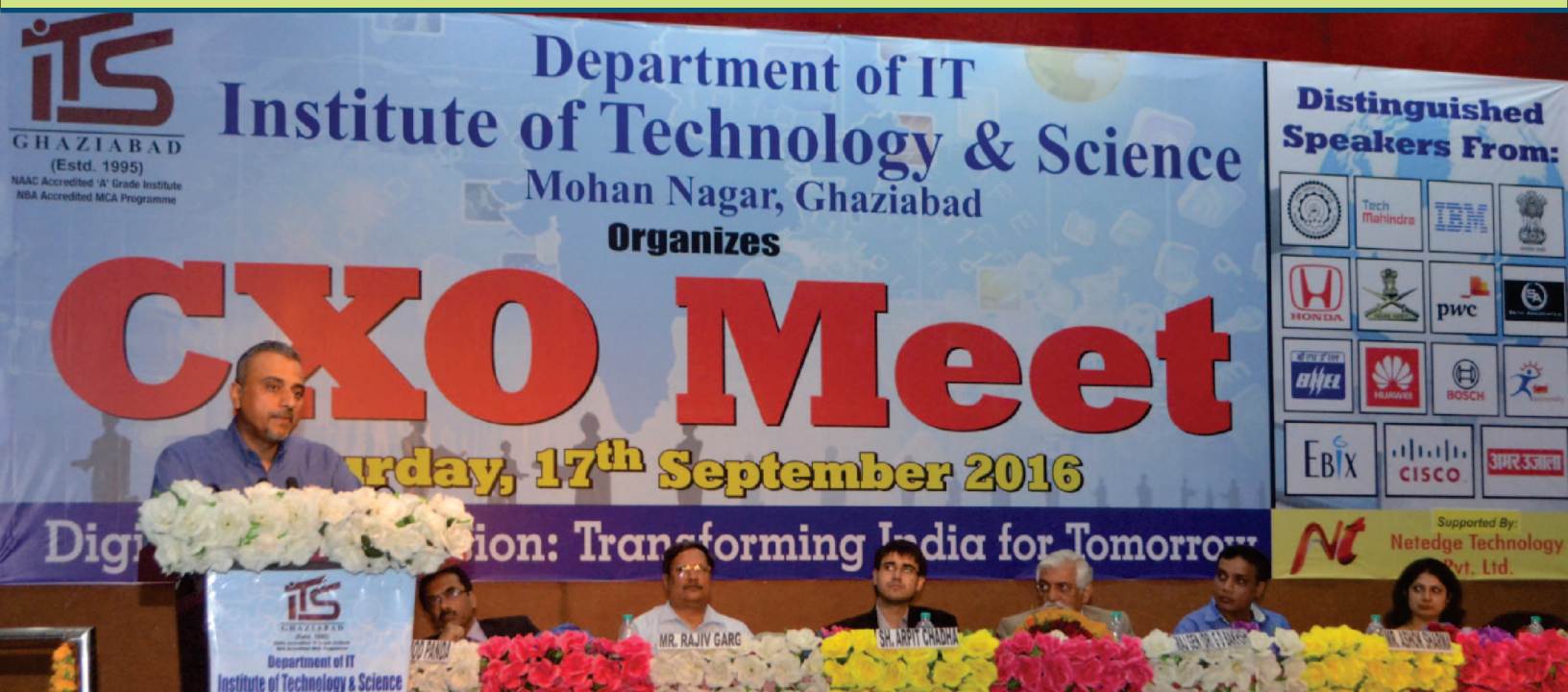

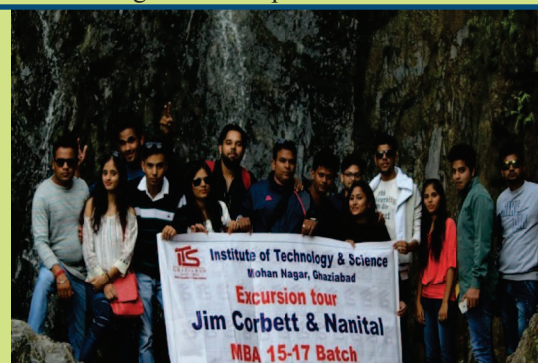
25th-26th October, 2016 – "Poster Making Competition" and "Best Class Room Award" were organized by 5S team

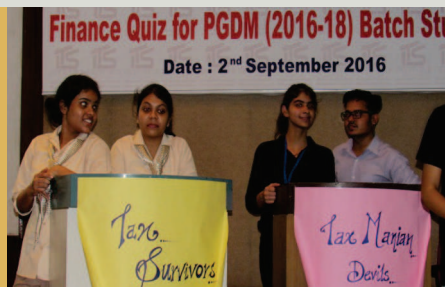


29th - 31st August, 2016 - C- Club of Department of IT Conducted 2-Day Workshop in Advanced C
