



Binary – IT Club of Department of Management organized online activity "LONE WARRIORS" for Management students on August 9, 2020.




Department of Management organized alumni talk on the topic "Create Opportunities. Don't Wait for them" for MBA Batch (2019-21) students on October 31, 2020.
